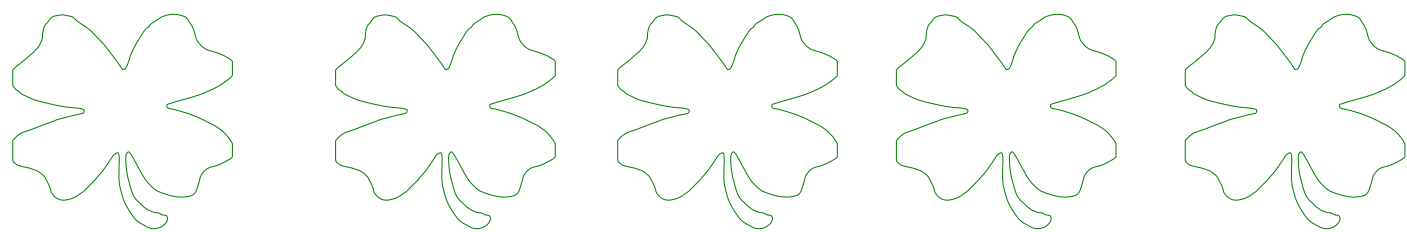
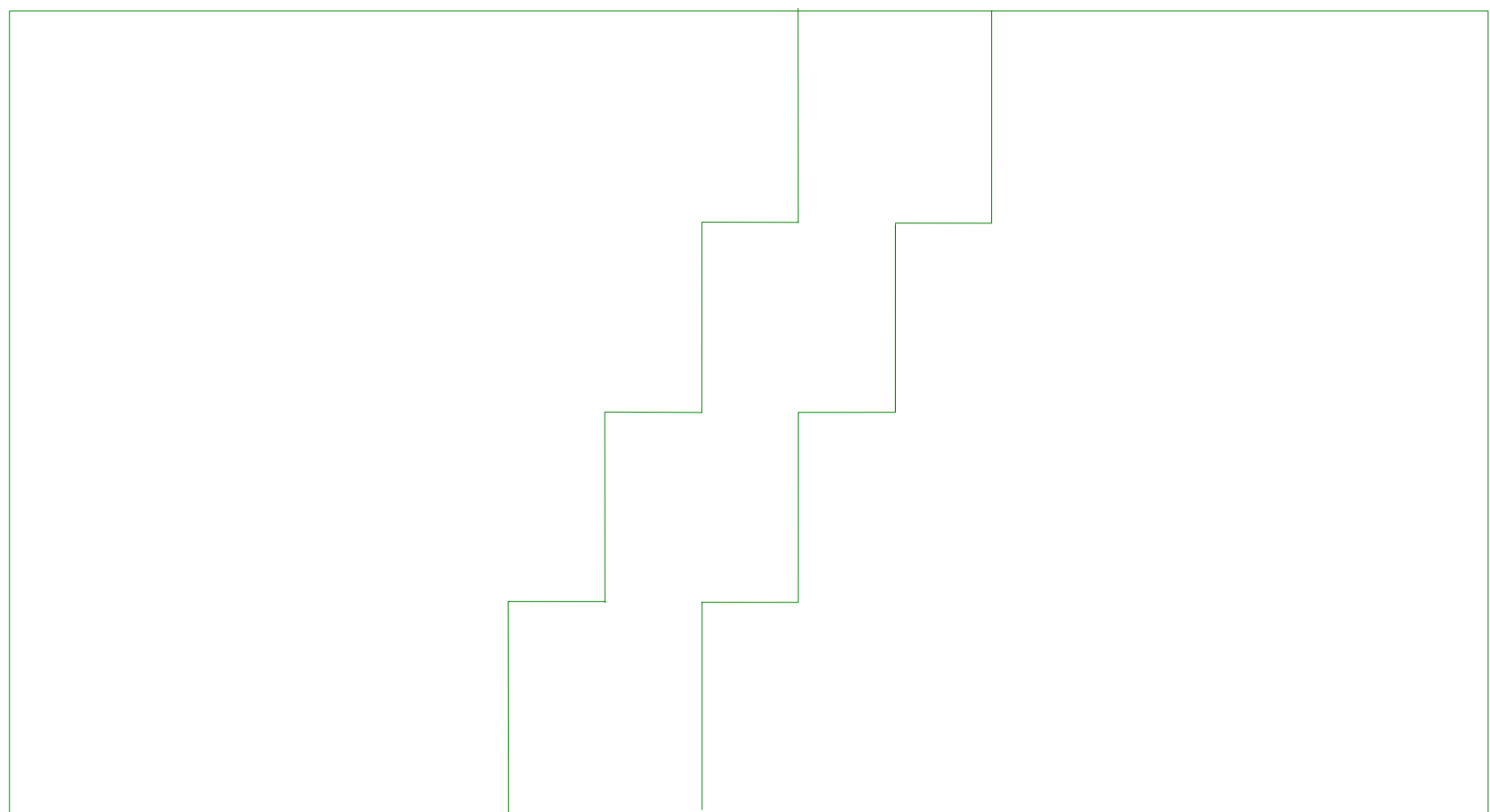
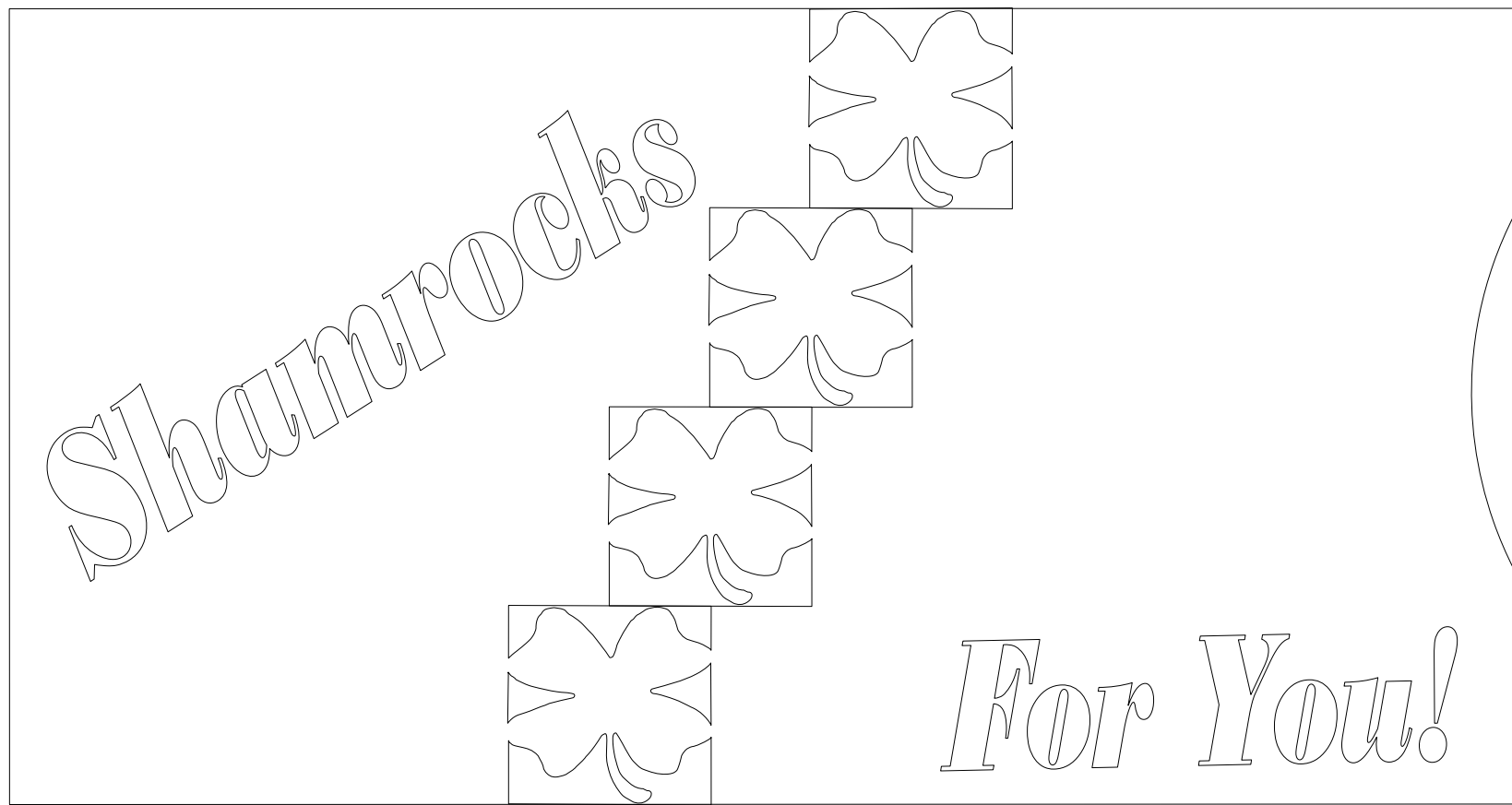


Stand alone cards with Hearts and Shamrocks.

Cutting Notes: Both cards were cut from cardstock.

The designs in black were cut from white and are the top layer.
Green was used to cut the backing on the shamrock card and the shamrock shapes.
Red was used to to cut the backing on the heart card and the heart shapes.



- Assembly suggestions:
1. After all pieces are cut, carefully, glue the backing to each side of the top, keeping the center edges by the cut shapes flush. You should have a 1/8" extension of the backing around the outside edges.
 2. Also, note that the right side of the card has to be left open for the tag to be inserted. So, just come around the corner with glue to leave the opening.
 3. The next step is to glue the colored shapes down the center and on the tag.
 4. Carefully fold the card, concealing the shapes down the center for the element of surprise when the card is removed from the envelope.
