

# High Sierra Fix for MTC Not Opening

1. Close MTC if it's currently running.
2. Right click on MTC icon and select **Show Package Contents**.
3. Double click on the **Wineskin** icon.
4. Select **Advanced**.
5. Click on **Set Screen Options**.
6. Uncheck the option for **Auto Detect GPU Info for Direct3D**.
7. Click on **Done**. You should be back in the **Wineskin Advanced** window.
8. Click on the **Tools** tab.
9. Click on **Winetricks**.
10. At the top, type in *video* in the search window and click on the search icon to the left.
11. Open the settings list by clicking on the little triangle icon to left of it.
12. Mark the option for **2048MB RAM**. Click on **Run**.
13. Wait for the process to finish and click on **Close**.
14. Close out of all windows and then try opening MTC.



Note: if you get the following error:

Go to the **Tools** tab and click on **Kill Wineskin Processes** and answer **Yes**. Then try again.
