

# Donut Seeds



Plant anytime of the year. On the North side of the house, dig a hole 6' deep & 8' long. In the dark of the moon at midnight, plant seeds about 2' apart.  
For Frosted Donuts - sprinkle blooms with sugar.  
For Chocolate Covered Donuts - fertilize with chocolate syrup. Water with coffee and donuts will have handles for dunking.  
You must BELIEVE!  
If nothing grows, you end up with Donut Holes!!!

Donut Seeds are actually Cherrios. After your file has been printed and cut, use a small ziplock bag (approx 2" square) and put about 7 Cheerios in it. Use double sided tape on the top and bottom edges of the bag and position it behind the hole in the front of the envelope.

There are no pounce lines in this file because it is expected that it will be printed and cut on lightweight paper. Fold the side flaps in first, then fold the back of the envelope up, and finally fold the top flap down. Glue the sides of the back flap to the side flaps where they overlap and then glue the top flap down.

Add registration marks if you are doing a print and cut. Select only the items you want to print. The words "Dounut Seeds" can be printed or cut separately to add to the envelope.

When you are ready to cut, be sure you are cutting only the envelope shape.
