- 1. Close MTC if it's currently running.
- 2. Right click on MTC icon and select Show Package Contents.
- 3. Double click on the **Wineskin** icon.
- 4. Select Advanced.
- 5. Click on Set Screen Options.
- 6. Uncheck the option for Auto Detect GPU Info for Direct3D.
- 7. Click on **Done**. You should be back in the **Wineskin Advanced** window.
- 8. Click on the **Tools** tab.
- 9. Click on Winetricks.
- 10. At the top, type in video in the search window and click on the search icon to the left.
- 11. Open the settings list by clicking on the little triangle icon to left of it.
- 12. Mark the option for **2048MB RAM**. Click on **Run**.
- 13. Wait for the process to finish and click on **Close**.
- 14. Close out of all windows and then try opening MTC.
